HISTORY

Magnolia Plantation is an agricultural complex located south of Natchitoches, Louisiana on Cane River Lake, an oxbow lake of the Red River system. Jean Baptiste LeComte I (died 1784) first received part of the land that later became Magnolia Plantation in a Spanish grant during the mid-eighteenth century. His descendants Ambrose LeComte I (1760-1834), Jean Baptiste LeComte II (1786-1825), and Ambrose LeComte II (1807-1883), purchased additional holdings in the 1820s and 1830s, which formally established a plantation over 7,800 acres.

By 1850, Magnolia was a prosperous plantation, with 182 enslaved workers and real estate holdings worth \$125,000. In 1852, Matthew Henry Hertzog (1829-1903) married Ambrose LeComte II's daughter Atala LeComte (1830-1897). Soon afterward, Hertzog assumed management of the plantation, although LeComte retained majority ownership. In 1860, Ambrose LeComte II was the largest slaveholder and largest producer of cotton in Natchitoches Parish. The Magnolia main house was burned by Union troops during the Red River Campaign of the Civil War, and although the LeComte-Hertzog holdings declined during the 1870s, the plantation continued to produce cotton during the Reconstruction period and the remainder of the nineteenth century. During this time, slave labor was replaced by sharecroppers, tenant farmers, and day laborers. The Hertzog family paid these laborers in a combination of cash, residence and farming sites, and store credit. This credit could be redeemed at the plantation store (established, circa 1873), which offered merchandise including medicine, food, clothing, and farming supplies. Upon Ambrose LeComte II's death in 1883, Matthew and Atala Hertzog inherited Magnolia Plantation, which continued to function as a working cotton plantation under subsequent Hertzog generations. The materials in this collection primarily document the early to late twentieth century, when the plantation stopped functioning. During that period, Magnolia Plantation was owned and operated by Matthew Hertzog's son, Ambrose John Hertzog (1857-1921), and his wife, Sarah Jane "Sallie" Hunter (1873-1960), until it was inherited by their son, Matthew Hertzog (1897-1973). Matthew Hertzog married Eleanor Lydia "Dee" Compton (1903-1988), and they had one daughter, Elizabeth "Betty" Hertzog (born 1929).

In the Cane River region, local people historically classified themselves and others as members of one of three principal ethnic categories: (1) "Creoles of color," who descended from the cultural and biological meeting of African, French, Spanish, and American Indian peoples; (2) "whites," including "French Creole" descendants of French European ancestors (as distinct from "Anglos" or "Americans"); or (3) "blacks," who were primarily of African descent. These categories were generally separated by race, religion, and social status, with the French Creole Hertzog family members who owned Magnolia Plantation representing the highest social and economic rank. Until the mid-twentieth century, Magnolia Plantation also served as the center of a community of Creoles of color and blacks who lived and worked on or near the plantation as tenant farmers, sharecroppers, and laborers, as it provided them with food and shelter, health care, religious ministering, and a limited cash income.

The plantation system was common in the South until the mid-twentieth century, and was a significant element of American agricultural production. The system revolved around a cash crop grown on a large scale for profit. The most successful plantations required large units of fertile land, abundant, and cheap labor, on-site preliminary processing techniques, and methods of transport to and from a network of factors and factoring houses to market cash crops. All of these were present in Louisiana during the antebellum period. The system underwent changes after the Civil War, with the use of sharecroppers and tenant labor instead of enslaved workers. In this modified form, the plantation system continued to dominate Southern agriculture from the Reconstruction period until the early twentieth century, when the invasion of the boll weevil, the departure of laborers for urban jobs, and the mechanization of agriculture led to its decline.

Cotton emerged as the principal cash crop in the plantation South during the nineteenth century largely due to Eli Whitney's 1793 invention of the cotton gin, which was the first mechanical process to remove seeds from cotton. In the typical system for processing the cotton crop for market, cotton was hand-picked and ginned on the plantation and then compressed into four or five hundred pound bales for ease of transport. Ginning was initially a tedious and labor-intensive process, but was improved by the advent of "system ginning" in the late nineteenth century, and the transition from mule power to steam power. The Lecomte-Hertzog Family ginned cotton at Magnolia Plantation as early as 1830 with a wood screw press and continued to improve and expand their gin house into the twentieth century. In 1939, Magnolia stopped ginning its own cotton and began taking its cotton to large gins that serviced area farmers, following a trend across the South during the 1930s and 1940s.

Magnolia Plantation continued in the Lecomte-Hertzog Family tradition of plantation-based agribusiness until the 1970s. Upon Matt Hertzog's death in 1973, the plantation system shifted to corporate farming, by which the lands of Magnolia Plantation were leased. The last residents domiciled at the enslaved workers' quarters and tenant cabins moved off-site during this transition. As of 2012, the main house was owned by the descendants of Ambrose John Hertzog and Sarah Jane Hunter Hertzog. These descendants also continue to lease the 2,400 acres of farm land. The Hertzog family donated the rest of the plantation structures and the land they stood on to Museum Contents, Inc. in 1982. The National Park Service acquired the property via donation from Museum Contents, Inc., and now owns and operates the site as the Magnolia Plantation Unit of the Cane River Creole National Historical Park (created in 1994 by an act of Congress, Public Law 103-499 [16USC410cc]). Magnolia is one of the largest and most intact plantation complexes in the southern United States, as within the boundaries of the 18.75 acres of the Magnolia Plantation Unit are twenty-one historic buildings and structures, almost all of which date to the nineteenth century, including slave cabins, a slave hospital, and a nineteenth century gin barn. In recognition of its significance as a largely intact plantation complex, Magnolia was listed as a National Historic Landmark in 2001.

DESCRIPTION

The Magnolia Plantation Records are the personal records of the Hertzog family and the operational records of Magnolia Plantation, a unit of Cane River Creole National Historical Park, located in Natchitoches Parish, Louisiana.

The records, created by laborers, overseers, store clerks, and planters, reflect the agricultural production of the plantation from the late nineteenth century through the twentieth century. Crop and labor books document the tenant and sharecropping labor systems of harvesting cotton and other crops. Other agribusiness records reflect the unique local economy created with the operation of the Magnolia Plantation Store, where laborers earned credit for goods and services provided by the Hertzog family, who in turn sold their cotton to area cotton ginneries.

The personal records of the Hertzog family contain mostly legal, financial and insurance documents. These records also include The Betty Hertzog Papers, a donation from the Hertzog family matriarch, as well as The Archie Boggs Papers, which include information on the succession of Magnolia Plantation in the late twentieth century before acquisition by the National Park service.

Records span from 1890 to 2009, with the bulk of the material dating from 1920 to 1970. The records were created by the Hertzog family and laborers whom they employed at Magnolia Plantation. The materials in this collection include ledgers, coupon books, receipts, invoices, agribusiness documents, correspondence, tax documents,

insurance documents, ephemera, maps, aerial photographs, checks and other financial documents.

ORGANIZATION

Organized into four series: Series I: Day Labor Ledgers, Series II: Plantation Store Records, Series III: Personal Records, Series IV: Checks and Financial Documents.

PROVENANCE

Magnolia Plantation Records are comprised primarily of one accession: CARI-7, which was originally donated to Museum Contents, Inc. in 1982, and later acquired by the National Park Service in 1996. These materials were physically removed from the Magnolia Plantation Store and transferred to a National Park Service curation facility in 1999. Additional materials come from CARI-145 (The Betty Hertzog Collection), which was donated by Betty Hertzog on November 1, 2010 and CARI-129 (Archives of Archie Boggs) which was donated by Dr. Dayna B. Lee in November 2009, who received the collection from the Boggs family.

SERIES DESCRIPTIONS

I. SERIES I: CROP AND LABOR BOOKS, 1898-1975

Arranged chronologically.

Ledgers and notebooks kept by plantation owners, overseers, store clerks and other laborers, including members of the Hertzog family. The books document the work of sharecroppers and tenants at Magnolia Plantation, showing amounts of crops harvested and credit earned for goods and services. Some books also document the cotton shipped to various ginneries by the Hertzog family on behalf of the workers. Titles of the books generally reflect the content, such as "Cotton Picking," "Cotton Shipments," "Cotton Settlements," "Crop Book," "Wage Book," and "Day Labor," but some were used for multiple types of record-keeping or reused later for different purposes. Where possible, original titles given by the creators were retained.

II. SERIES II: PLANTATION STORE RECORDS, 1890-1988, UNDATED

Organized into five subseries: Subseries A, Ledgers; Subseries B, Customer Purchases and Store Credits; Subseries C, Invoices; Subseries D, Agribusiness Documents; Subseries E, Gin Tickets.

Records documenting the operations of the Magnolia Plantation Store, and more broadly, the agribusiness activities of the Hertzog family. Records reflect the complex nature of the sharecropping and tenant farming system, particularly in the twentieth century, in which laborers lived and worked at Magnolia Plantation in exchange for goods and services available via the Magnolia Plantation Store.

Primarily ledgers, invoices, and gin tickets, with lesser amounts of manuals, catalogs, bills of sale, program guides, receipts, notes, pamphlets, bale tags, and coupons.

A. SUBSERIES A: LEDGERS, 1902-1972

Arranged alphabetically by subject, and thereunder chronologically.

Primarily contains ginning, purchase, and short book ledgers, that document the received and expended cash and credit at Magnolia Plantation. They largely reflect the exchange of money as it took place in the plantation store, and complement Subseries B and Subseries C of this series.

Notebooks, ledger books, and loose ledger pages.

B. SUBSERIES B: CUSTOMER PURCHASES AND STORE CREDITS, 1950-1963, UNDATED

Arranged chronologically.

Documents the purchases made by customers and tenants at the Magnolia Plantation Store.

Store coupons, receipts, and ledger books.

C. SUBSERIES C: INVOICES, 1890-1988, UNDATED

Arranged alphabetically in subject groupings that reflect those used by Magnolia Plantation's owners and administrators: Agribusiness and Hardware, Freight, General Merchandise, Grocery, Medical, Newspapers, Office Supplies, Poison and Plane, Utilities, Other Goods and Services. Materials are then organized alphabetically by company within each grouping, and chronologically thereunder.

Documents purchases of wholesale merchandise sold at the plantation store, supplies used on the farm and in the Hertzog home, and services, such as medical bills and utilities. Some materials, particularly in the Medical and Utilities groupings, relate to expenses incurred by tenants, which were paid by the plantation owner Matthew Hertzog, and then repaid by the tenants over time in a combination of cash, labor, and goods.

Primarily consists of invoices, receipts, and statements, with scattered associated materials including folders, correspondence, and notes and calculations.

D. SUBSERIES D: AGRIBUSINESS DOCUMENTS, 1915-1990, UNDATED

Arranged alphabetically by subject.

A variety of materials pertaining to the farming operations at Magnolia Plantation, including periodicals, manuals, agribusiness bulletins and informational documents, receipts, and crop liens. Also included are the files of accounts held with cotton ginners and warehouses which document the unique sale, purchase, and credit system of the cotton industry. These records primarily document the Hertzog family's operation of Magnolia Plantation, as opposed to the work of their laborers.

E. SUBSERIES E: GIN TICKETS, 1937-1976, UNDATED

Arranged alphabetically by gin, and thereunder chronologically.

Documents the sale, transportation and storage of cotton from the Hertzog family and Magnolia tenants and laborers with Natchitoches, Louisiana area gins. Tickets generally include the weight of cotton bale and amount of seed sold.

Tickets and ticket books from area gins and from the United States Department of Agriculture.

III. *SERIES III: PERSONAL RECORDS, 1916-2009, UNDATED*

Organized into five subseries: Subseries A, Correspondence; Subseries B, Government, Legal, and Tax Documents; Subseries C, Insurance Documents; Subseries D, Betty Hertzog Papers; Subseries E, Archie Boggs Papers.

Correspondence, tax forms, licenses, certificates, power of attorney documents, insurance policies, maps, brochures, and legal files, relating principally to the business activities of the Hertzog Family.

A. *SUBSERIES A: CORRESPONDENCE, 1917-1972*

Arranged chronologically.

Primarily business and solicitation correspondence to members of the Hertzog family.

B. *SUBSERIES B: GOVERNMENT, LEGAL, AND TAX DOCUMENTS, 1916-1988*

Arranged alphabetically by record type.

Primarily prepared income and sales tax forms that document the tax obligations of the Hertzog family and their agribusiness operations. Also contains records of employment, selective service cards, licenses and permits, and legal documents relating to the Hertzog family and their land.

Box 78, Folder 14 is restricted to viewing due to sensitive personal information.

C. *SUBSERIES C: INSURANCE DOCUMENTS, 1917-1988, UNDATED*

Arranged chronologically.

Primarily insurance policy documents of varying types, including auto, crop, employer's, fire, home, and federal crop insurance, as well as related materials including correspondence, billing statements and notifications.

D. *SUBSERIES D: BETTY HERTZOG PAPERS, 1921-1996, UNDATED*

Arranged alphabetically by record type.

Historical and geographical information concerning Natchitoches, Louisiana and the Cane and Red River regions, including an aerial photo survey conducted by the United States Army Corps of Engineers. These papers were donated from 2009 to 2011 (CARI-

145) by Hertzog family matriarch and Magnolia Plantation resident Betty Hertzog (born 1929).

E. SUBSERIES E: ARCHIE BOGGS PAPERS, 1921-2009 (bulk dates: 1952-1979)

Arranged chronologically.

Mostly legal documents, correspondence and notes concerning the succession of Magnolia Plantation among heirs. The materials also document the donation of Magnolia Plantation to Museum Contents, Incorporated, and the subsequent donation to the National Park Service. Also include an original photograph of Magnolia Plantation and a cassette tape with audio of meetings from 1976. Archie Boggs (1920-2009) married into the Hertzog family with his marriage to Sallie Hunter Holbrook, daughter of Marie Louise Hertzog (daughter of Ambrose Hertzog, and sister of Matthew Hertzog).

Folder titles are original from the files of Archie Boggs.

IV. SERIES IV: CHECKS AND FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS, 1900-1988, UNDATED

Organized into two subseries: Subseries A, Checkbooks, Checks, Statements and Stubs; Subseries B, Other Financial Materials.

Document the banking and financial activities of the Hertzog Family and their operation of Magnolia Plantation. Most materials pertain to Matthew Hertzog and his daughter, Betty Hertzog, and include both personal and business expenditures.

Primarily checkbooks, cancelled checks, bank statements, check stubs, bank forms and documents, and calculation papers.

A. SUBSERIES A: CHECKBOOKS, CHECKS, AND STATEMENTS, 1900-1985, UNDATED

Arranged chronologically.

Checks and statements were generally maintained in their original order, such that the checks are reflected on the corresponding statement in that folder. In some cases however, checks were not enclosed with statements, and were not returned together. These checks are noted by the parenthetical term "loose."

B. SUBSERIES B: OTHER FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS, 1910-1988, UNDATED

Arranged alphabetically by record type.

Bank forms and documents, bank books, lease and mortgage documents and other miscellaneous financial information.
