After the park ranger finishes the program students should construct a one paragraph (four sentences) letter to Tad about how they can make the world a cleaner place. After they are finished writing their letters the teacher should mail them to Russell Cave National Monument with the envelope provided by the park ranger or email them to RUCA_Information@nps.gov.
