SOP: VURn Guided Winter Activities

Timeline

Activity Reports can be submitted at anytime or on an ongoing basis. They are <u>due by January 31st</u> for the prior operating year. Once you've submitted your reports please monitor your email, NPS will reach out if revisions are needed.

Using VUR(n)

Access Visitor Use Reporting System (<u>VURn</u>) to report your trips. If you are a new user, you will need to create account. The <u>VURn User Guide</u> and <u>VURn YouTube</u> will provide you with directions for making a profile and entering trips. For DENA specific directions for Guided Winter Activities please follow the directions below.

Entering Guided Winter Activities in VURn- Denali National Park and Preserve Guidelines

- Please review the CUA stipulations and ensure all activities adhere to these rules.
- Guided hiking/ snowshoeing, kennels visits, and driving to Mountain Vista need to be reported.
- Trips that **only** went to the Winter Visitor Center do not need to be reported.
- Report only the PRIMARY trail for hiking/ snowshoeing. This is the trail you spent the most time on. You do not need to report access trails you may have briefly used to get to the primary trail.
- If the same group completes two separate hikes they should be reported as one trip with two locations.
- Guided hiking/ snowshoeing group size is limited to a total of 12 people including the guide. If a larger group splits up for hiking they need to be reported as two separate trips.

Examples

1. Play in Snow LLC brings 30 people and 3 guides to Winter Visitor Center and then they split into three groups. Two groups hike the Roadside Trail staggering 15 minutes between them while the third group remains at the visitor center and does not hike. Then the whole group drives to Mountain Vista.
