

# Fort Baker to Cavallo Point

- **From Post to Park** In 1973 Fort Baker was listed as a Historic District in the National Register of Historic Places. When the Golden Gate National Parks were established in 1972, Fort Baker was transferred to the National Park Service

# Cavallo Point

- Operated by Preferred Hotel Group
- High-end Resorts and Boutique Properties
- Over 100 locations in US and at least another 100 around the globe
- The *Lodge at Cavallo Point* includes a five-star restaurant, culinary school, spa and lodging

# The Lodge

- Construction began in October 2006
- Thirteen historic lodging buildings and seven historic commons buildings were renovated
- Thirteen new lodging buildings were constructed
- 15,000 square feet of indoor space and 10,000 square feet of outdoor event space
- A restaurant seating 100 people
- An 11,000-square-foot full-service spa
- 142 guest rooms

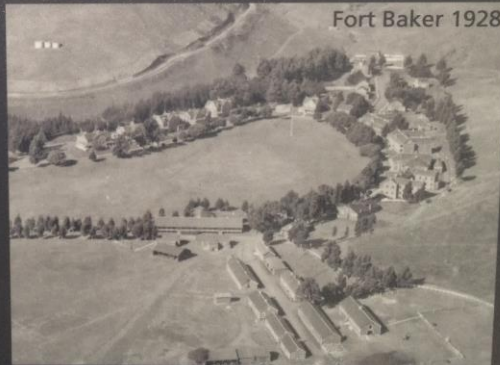
