 From Post to Park In 1973 Fort Baker was listed as a Historic District in the National Register of Historic Places. When the Golden Gate National Parks were established in 1972, Fort Baker was transferred to the National Park Service

Cavallo Point

- Operated by Preferred Hotel Group






