

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Glen Canyon NRA Failed to Complete Lead Service Line Inventory by Due Date

As our customers, you have a right to know that all community water systems and non-transient non-community water systems were required to submit an initial inventory to their state or primacy agency **by October 16, 2024**. **The Lead Service Line Inventory for Glen Canyon NRA was submitted to ADEQ December 10, 2024.**

Public water systems must notify customers that are served by a lead, galvanized requiring replacement or lead status unknown service line as identified in the initial inventory within 30 days of submitting the initial inventory to the state following 40 CFR 141.85(e). If you **did not** receive a notification, you **do not** have a lead, galvanized requiring replacement or lead status unknown service line.

**Service line inventories are the foundation from which water systems can take proactive steps to address lead service lines. Establishing an inventory of service line materials and identifying the location of lead service lines are key steps in getting them replaced. **

What does this public notice this mean?

This is not an emergency, as we have completed the initial lead service line inventory. If it had been an emergency, you would have been notified within 24 hours.

You would have been notified **within 30 days of finishing our inventory** if any lines are determined to be lead, galvanized requiring replacement or lead status unknown.

What is being done?

GLCA NRA has completed the initial inventory and has posted this public notice in good faith to correct the missed deadline.
