Introduction

Golden Gate National Recreation Area

Park Description

Golden Gate National Recreation Area (GGNRA), a unit of the National Park Service, was established by an Act of Congress on October 27, 1972. The 80,000-acre park encompasses a great diversity of cultural and natural resources in and around the Bay Area of San Francisco, California. It includes Muir Woods National Monument and Fort Point National Historic Site.

The park holds almost five million three-dimensional and documentary artifacts dating from the time before European contact to the present. They are preserved and maintained for the public by the Division of Cultural Resources and Museum Management, which includes the Park Archives and Records Center (PARC).

Park Archives and Records Center

Historical Note

GGNRA and the sites within it have been collecting records since their inception. The PARC was established in 1994 to receive records and archival collections from the U.S. Army and the Presidio Army Museum after the closure of the Presidio of San Francisco as an Army base. The collections continue to grow through the donation of materials by private individuals, transfer of inactive park records by staff, and acquisition of relevant documentary materials.

Scope of Collections

The archival collections in the custody of the GGNRA document the history and activity of the various sites and groups associated with the park, described in the park's Scope of Collection Statement (2009).

The PARC contains U.S. Army and National Park Service facility records for the Presidio of San Francisco, forts and coast defense sites in the area, and various GGNRA sites. Subjects and sites documented include the United States Army (Bear Flag Revolt, Civil War, Spanish-American War, Mexican War, World War I, Army Air Service, Coast Artillery, Army medical facilities and issues, World War II, Army support during natural disasters, Viet Nam War, and Operation Desert Storm); Alcatraz Island (Army fortress, Army Disciplinary Barracks, U.S. Penitentiary, and Indian Occupation); the natural resources conservation movement resulting in the establishment of Muir Woods National Monument; agriculture in the Marin Headlands; Point Reyes Peninsula and Bolinas Lagoon areas; U.S. Lifesaving/Coast Guard Services; San Francisco Earthquake and Fire of 1906; Panama Pacific International Exposition of 1915; natural resources and environmental issues; and preservation of open space in the Bay Area. Also included in the PARC are many of the GGNRA administrative records that document the development and expansion of this park.

Visiting the PARC for Research

The PARC is located in an historic brick building, formerly a cavalry stable, on the Presidio of San Francisco. Collections and archives support services are available for walk-in research during open hours or by appointment. Please contact the PARC (see below) for the current schedule of reference hours.

Copy Services

Black and white photocopy services for standard and oversize materials are available on-site. Color photocopying, photographic duplication, and duplication of other media are available by special arrangement. Researchers are charged for all duplicates on a cost-recovery basis.

Rights and Publications

Copies are provided under the Fair Use provisions of the Copyright Law (Title 17, U.S.C.). Researchers must complete a Permission to Publish Contract form with the Park Archivist for any other intended use of these materials (such as publication or exhibit). Researchers should consult with staff regarding their needs for commercial or public use of materials.

Legal Status of Holdings

Many holdings of the PARC were acquired/transferred prior to the establishment of the archives program, and have little documentation on their provenance (source/chain of custody). All materials received after 1994 have been accessioned and documented. If provenance cannot be determined, the PARC assumes that it owns the property rights, but does <u>not</u> own the copyright. Staff will provide assistance, but it is the responsibility of the researcher to acquire permission from the copyright holder to cite, quote, or reproduce collection materials.

Collections developed by or for government organizations or operations are in the public domain and may be used, cited, and quoted without restriction, provided they are properly credited to the PARC. The archives contain no national security classified materials.

Donations to the Collections

The PARC welcomes donations of a variety of historic materials that meet the criteria in the Scope of Collections Statement and do not duplicate existing holdings. Collections are maintained for research use in perpetuity; there is no guarantee that items will be exhibited. If you own materials that may be relevant to the themes of GGNRA and would like to deposit them in the PARC, please consult with an archivist.

Provenance

The Armand Putz Family Collection was donated by Susan Thomas, granddaughter of Armand Putz who was the bandmaster of the Third Artillery Corps band at the Presidio of San Francisco from turn of the early 1900s until 1925.

Description

The collection depicts the musical history of Armand Putz, Third Artillery Bandmaster at the Presidio of San Francisco from 1900s to 1925, his musical performance career with the United States Army, and materials representing his descendants. The collection is comprised of photographs, original music scores, published music, books, war ration books, journals, newspapers, and a scrapbook that has many articles written about Armand Putz's musical and personal career.

History

Armand Putz was born in the south of France at an unknown date. Armand was an exquisite cornet soloist, a master trumpeter, and a competitive fencer. He arrived in New Orleans, Louisiana in 1884, joining the United State Army as a cornet player. Putz moved to Dallas, Texas in 1887 where he was appointed Chief of his musical society and Bandmaster of the Third Regiment National Guard. In 1889, Armand went to live in New York where he obtained great success in the Regiment's band at the Sea Beach Palace of Coney Island, a whimsical amusement park and resort where he directed music for four seasons. In 1896, Armand's band joined Captain Paul Boyton's Aquatic Traveling Circus and the following year his music was chosen for concerts at Lagoon Island, a resort on the shore of the Hudson River in New York. Perhaps his most famous and significant direction was for the Third Artillery Band at the Presidio of San Francisco beginning in the early 1900s. The twenty five plus member band played around the Bay Area and California including the Greek Theater in Berkeley, California, Golden Gate Park, San Francisco, California, and Piedmont Park, Oakland, California. The band performed in

competitions and schools around California. Although Armand was serving for the United States Army, he was widely admired back in his birth country of France as a member of the Society of Beautiful Arts of France as well as his efforts on behalf of French residents in San Francisco during the great fire and earthquake of 1906. Armand was an active member in the Bay Area community as the instructor of the Loyal Sons' Band No. 1 of Oakland, Noble Putz of the Islam Temple Shriner's band in San Francisco, member of the Masonic Golden Gate Lodge No. 30 in San Francisco, and bandmaster of the Petaluma Municipal Band. Armand married Edythe S. McGuire, New York socialite, in the Presidio Chapel on May 8, 1910. They had two children together, Jean and Harriet. Armand retired in 1925 and resided in Santa Cruz, California until his death in1936. He is buried in the San Francisco National Cemetery at the Presidio of San Francisco.

The Armand Putz Family Collection is made of two Series. The first series focuses on the musical career of Armand Putz including his military service. Series two contains later materials collected by later family members which relate to their WWII experience.

Description: News articles, photographs, a journal, a scrapbook of Armand Putz's musical success throughout the United States and mainly within the Bay Area from 1880 until his death 1936, his hand written music, and published musical works. This series is divided into three sub-series. Oversize materials have been separated and housed according to size.

Subseries A: Personal Papers

This subseries consists of newspapers, a handwritten journal dated 1880-1892, small musical books on trumpets, cornets, a music dictionary, and a scrapbook with news clippings of Armand with concert reviews, stories of his fencing career, travel, news of the 3rd artillery band, letters, his marriage, his retirement, membership card with the Masonic temple, Elks Lodge, and Shriners, and even news from his home back in France

Subseries B: Photographs

Nine images of Armand fencing, Armand with his band in a parade (possibly in San Francisco), Armand in his later years, portraits of Armand in his uniform, and a portrait of an instrument maker, Col. C. G. Conn.

Subseries C: Music

Comprised of Armand's hand written oversized music books (one of the books has musical writings from his son, Jean A. Putz in it as well but the majority of the oversize handwritten music books were written by Armand), and published musical works of Armand like "Welcome to California" "The Presidio Waltz", and "Come on to Treasure Island", a piece that him and his son created. This subseries is organized by individual musical pieces that were written by Armand first then pieces that were written by him and his son
