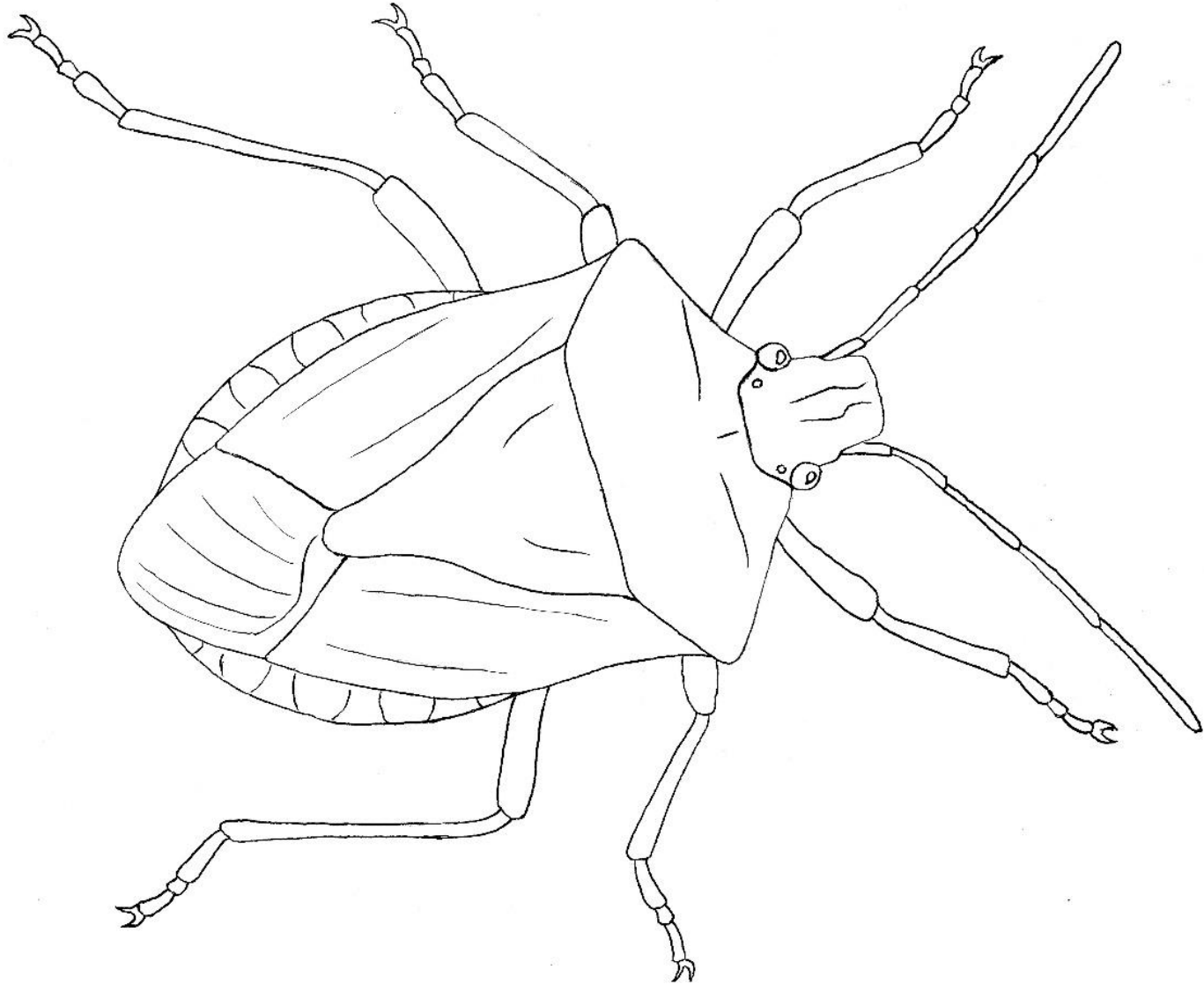
Rhopalidae: scentless plant bugs



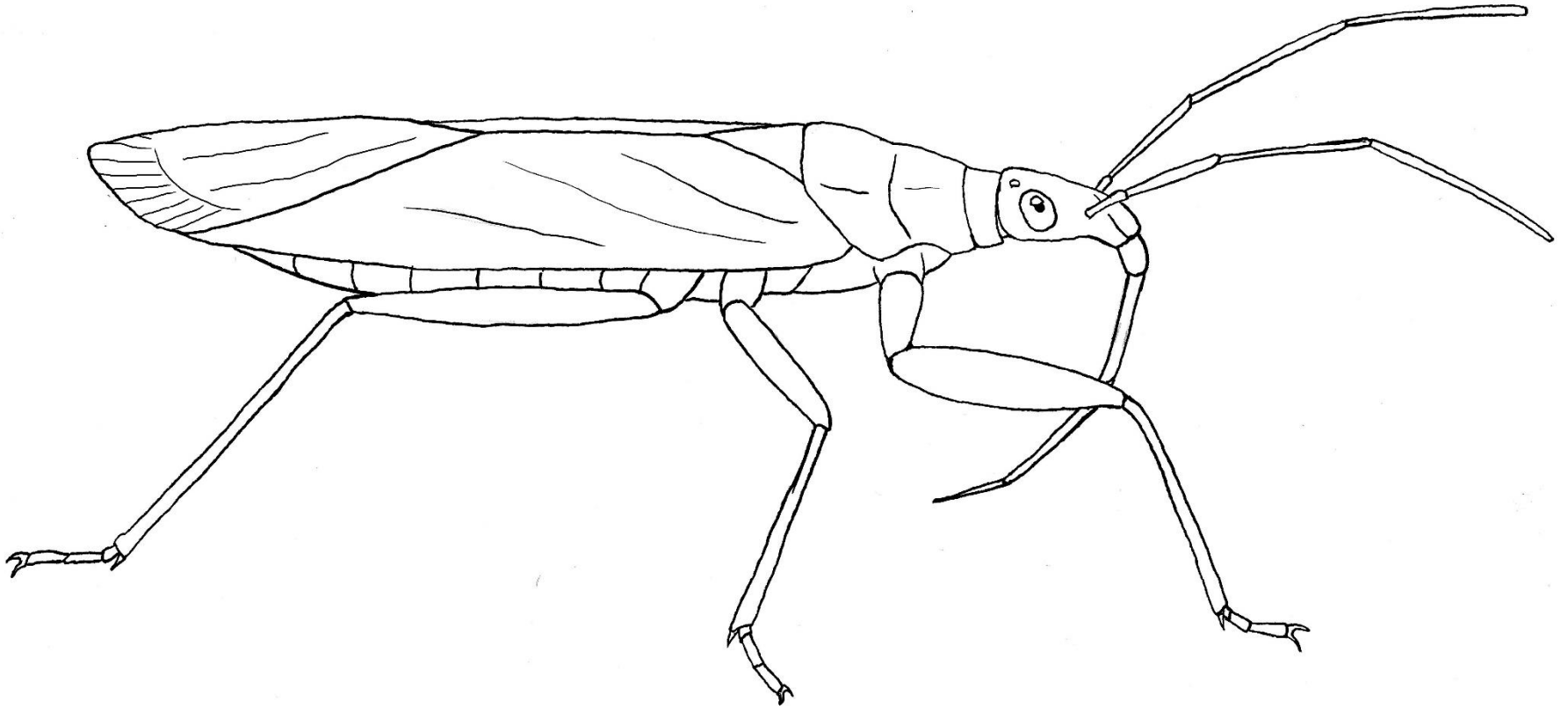

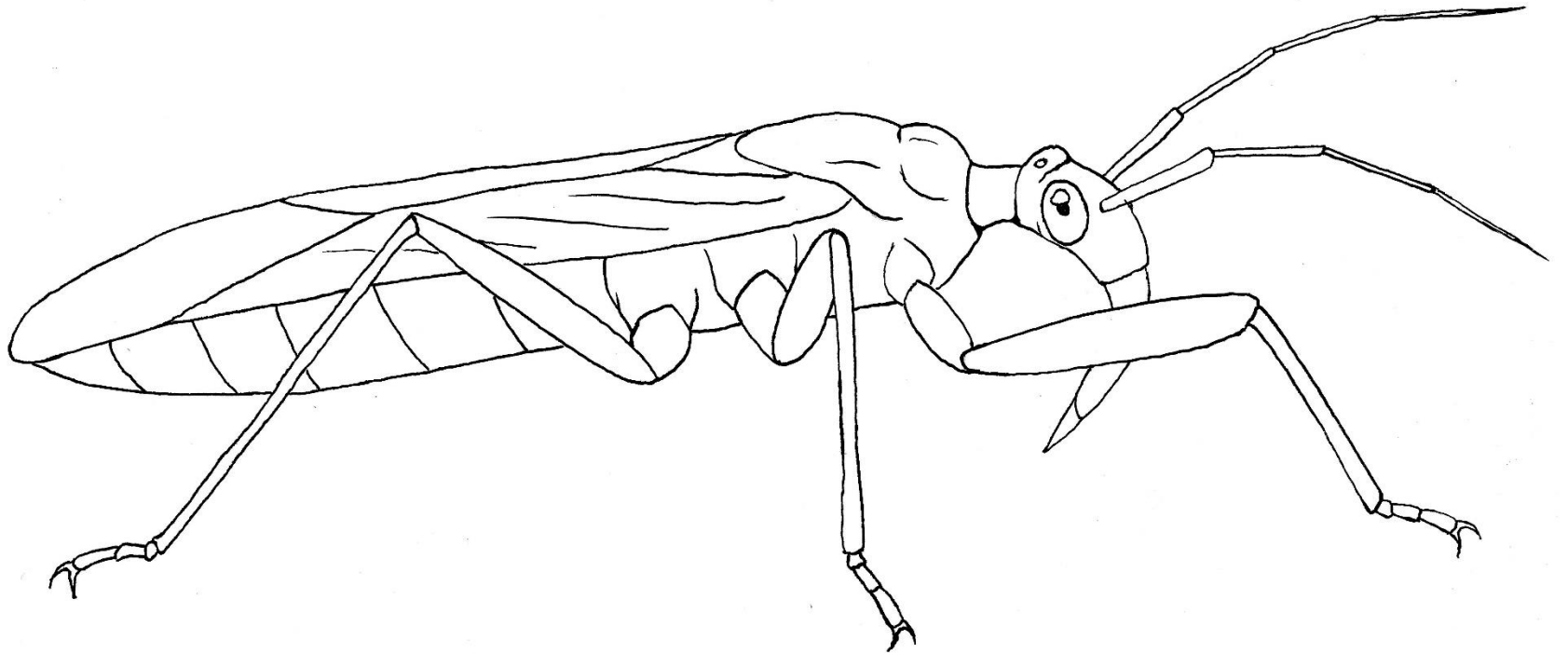

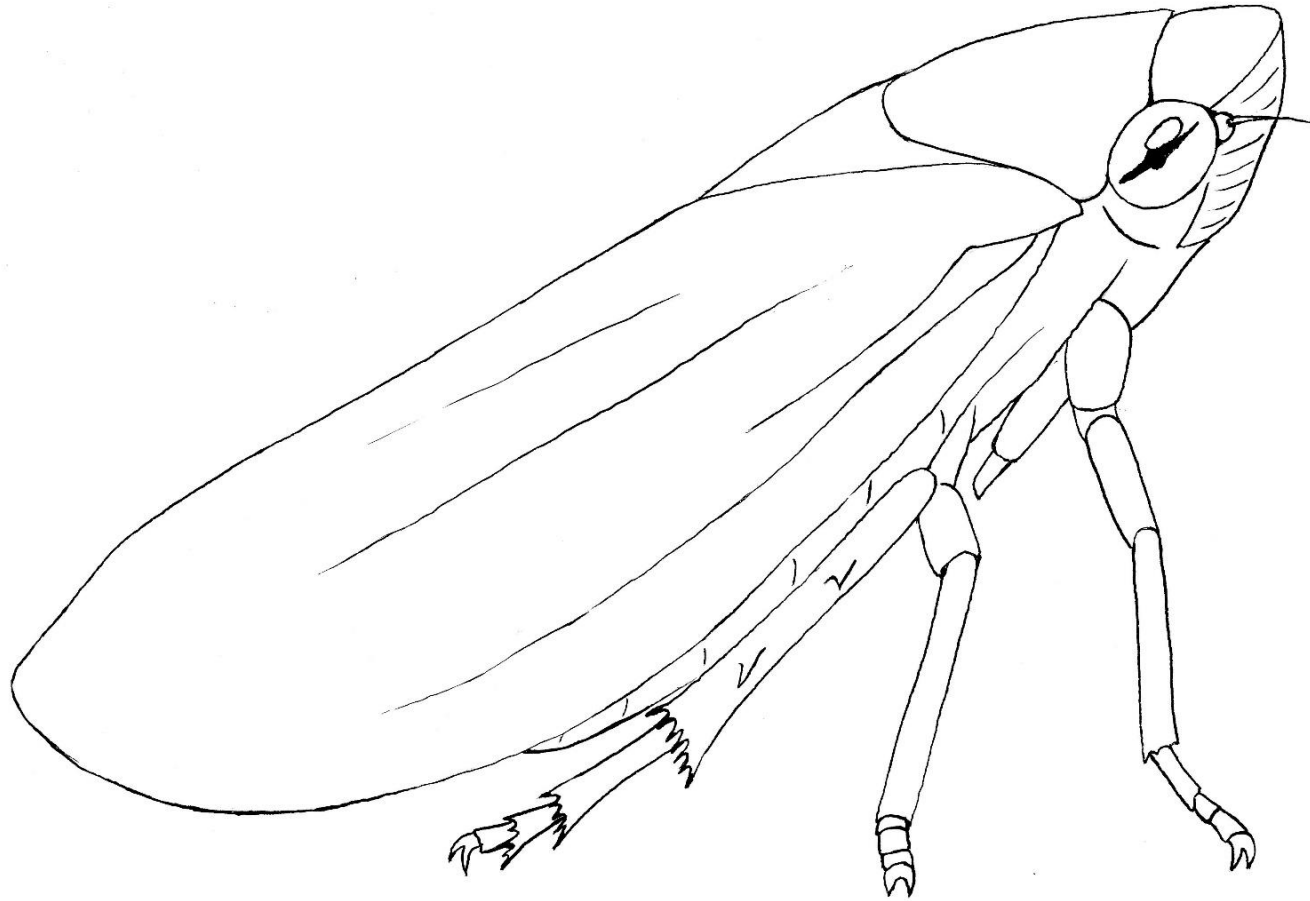

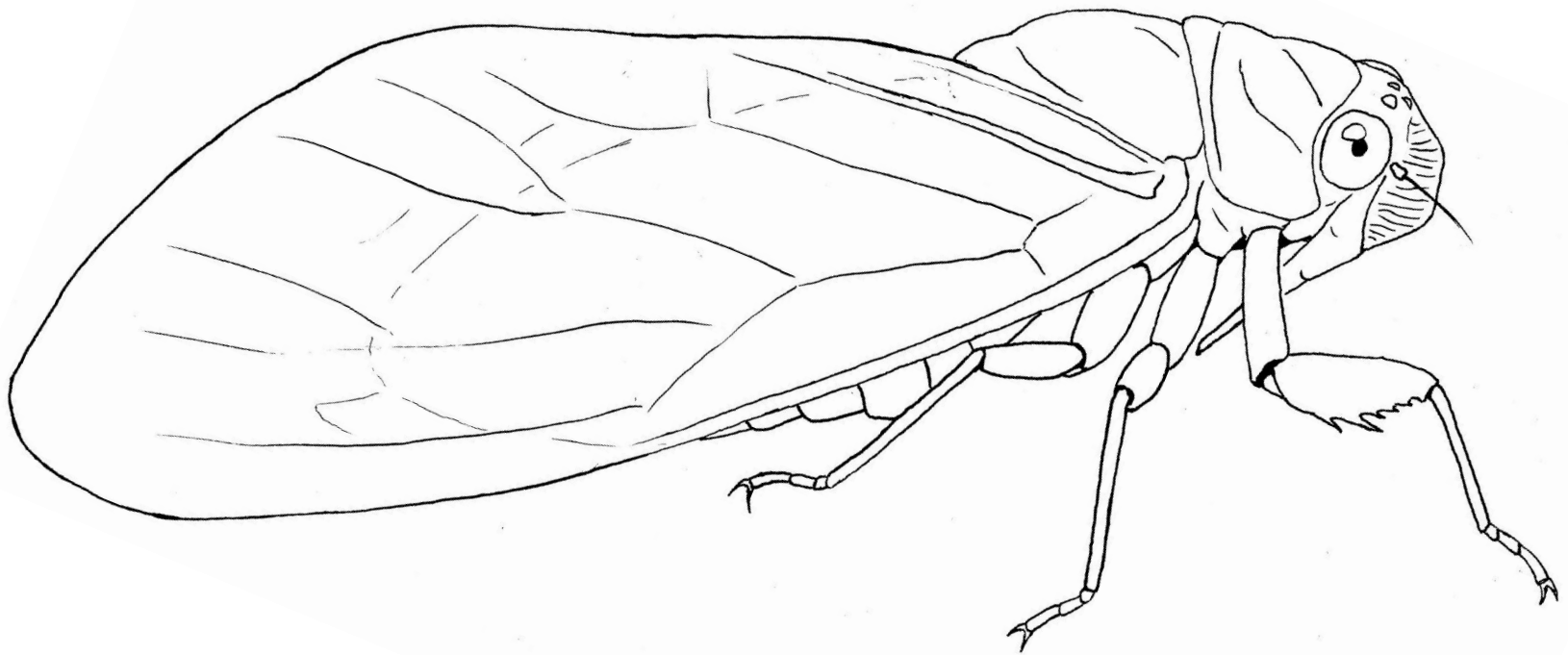

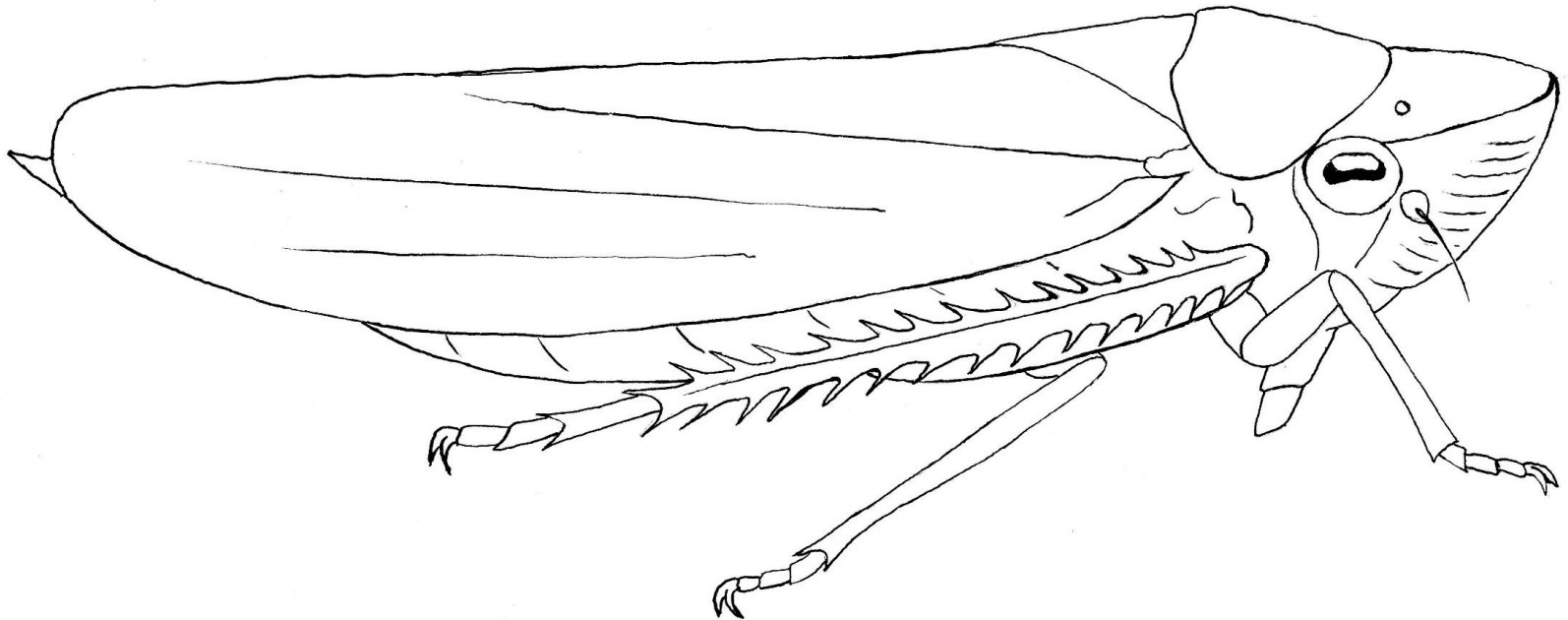

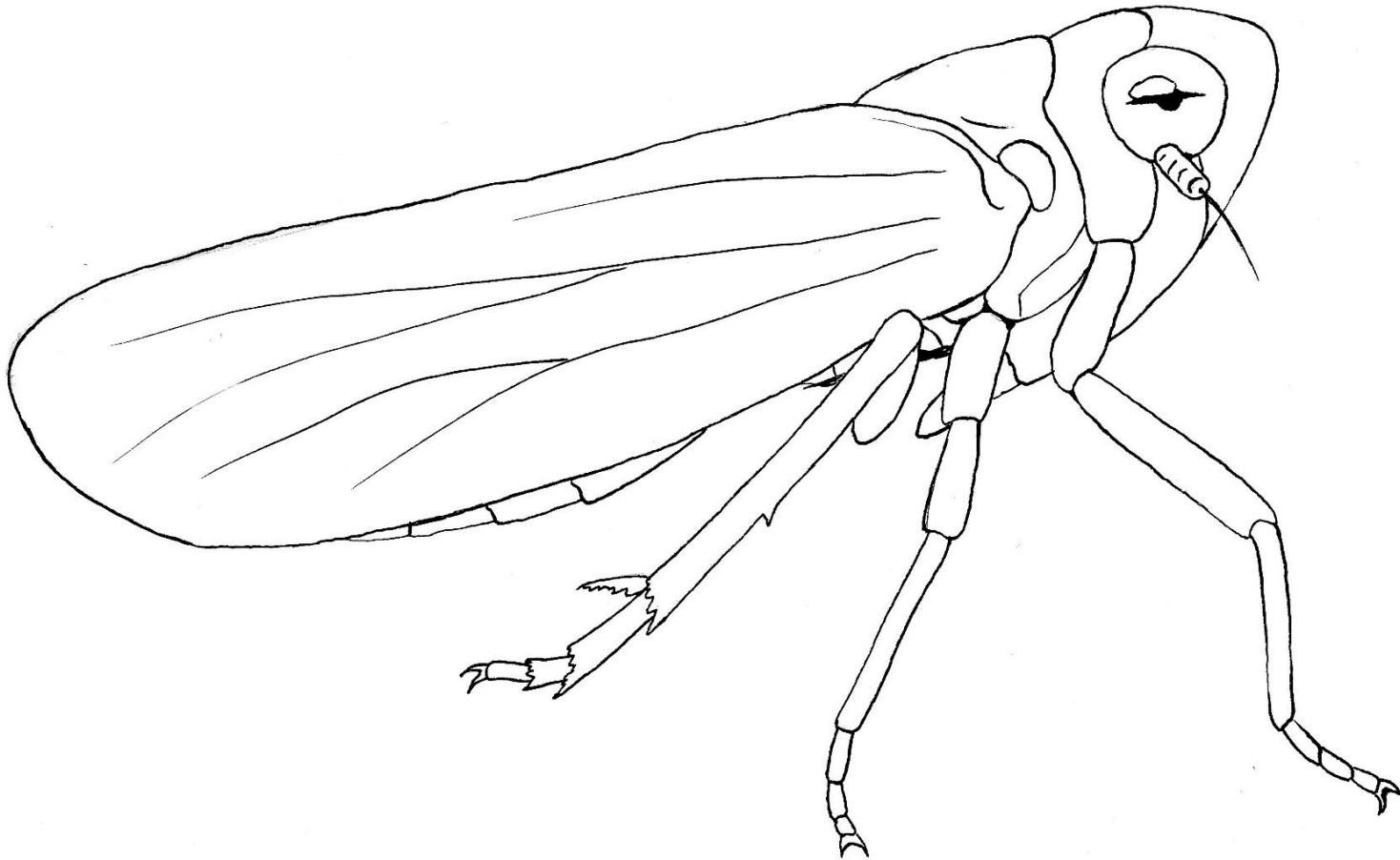

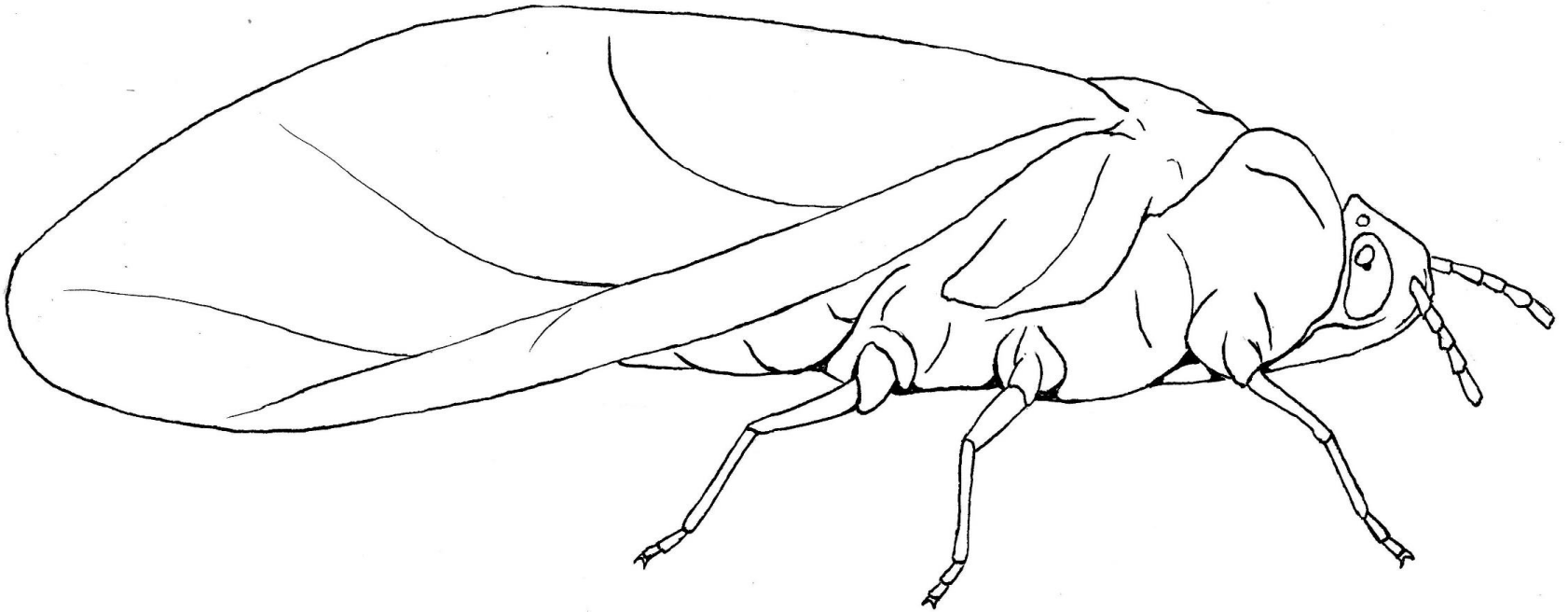
