



2025 Timed Entry Reservations



In 2025 timed entry reservations are required to enter the Sunrise Corridor from 7 am to 5 pm daily, July 11 - Sept 1, and weekends & holidays, Sept 2 - end of season (approx. mid-Oct). Next-day reservations will be released starting at 7 pm Pacific Time (PT) daily. Advance reservations will not be available starting Sept 2.



Reservations must be made on Recreation.gov, Rec.gov App, or by phone. Tickets will not be available at entrance stations.



Once you've secured your reservation, don't forget your timed entry ticket and photo ID. Show your park pass or pay the entrance fee with credit, debit, or other forms of electronic payment.

Why Timed Entry?

Mount Rainier National Park has experienced an approximate 40% increase in visitation over the last 10 years, leading to overcrowding during the summer and damage to fragile ecosystems. The 2024 pilot was particularly

successful in meeting park objectives in the Sunrise Corridor, resulting in reduced wait times and parking congestion and improved visitor experiences.

Other Park Reservations

- Visitors who acquire a first-come first-served permit at White River Campground within the Sunrise Corridor can use their camping permit instead of a timed entry reservation to gain access to the Sunrise Corridor. See the FAQ page for details.
- Visitors with Wilderness Permits or Special Use Permits for use within the Sunrise Corridor can use their permits instead of a timed entry reservation. Check your permit carefully for instructions for your specific permit; access varies.


Visit Without A Reservation

All areas of the park require a park entrance fee or park pass to enter. Timed entry reservations to enter the Sunrise Corridor are not required if you:

- Enter before 7 am or after 5 pm
- Enter weekdays Sept. 2 - end of season (approx. mid-Oct.)
- Enter on foot or bike
- Have a wilderness, research, commercial, or special use permit

Most areas of the park do not require a timed entry reservation at any time this year. These are:

- Longmire, Paradise in the southwest corner of the park.
- Stevens Canyon along the southeast side of the park.
- SR410, SR123, and Tipsoo Lake on the east side of the park.
