Trail Length Varies from 3 to 10 miles round trip.
Be prepared and know the rules!

This is a backcountry area.

- Gravel and dirt road access. Road can be difficult to travel due to deep ruts, holes, and mud.
- No cell service.
- Limited parking.
- No drinking water.
- Vault toilet only at parking lot.

Pets are prohibited on trails. Dogs can stress wildlife, make them flee, and expose them to predators. Porcupines, skunks, and wolves can hurt dogs.

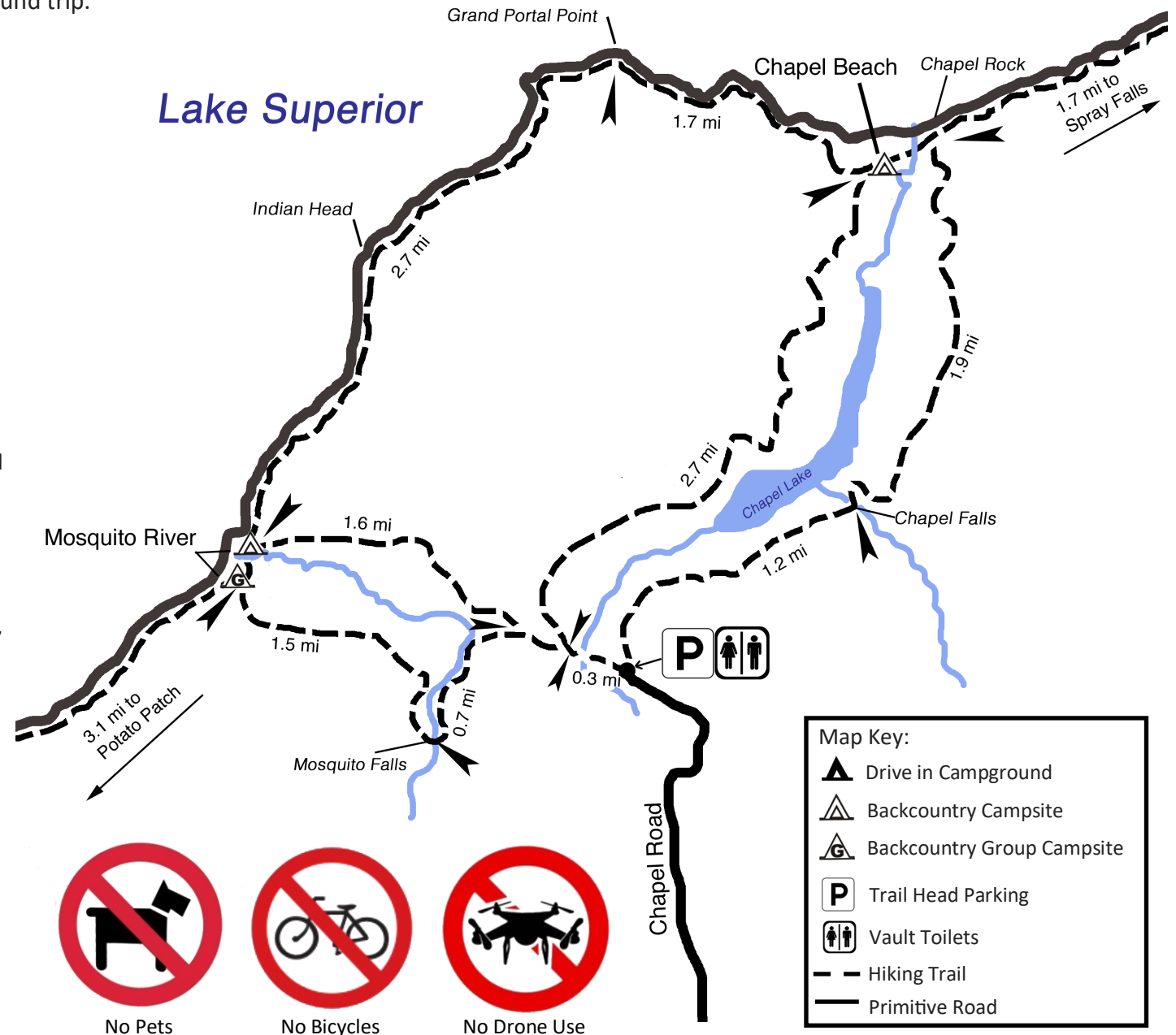
Permits are required for all camping!
Permits available via www.recreation.gov

Leave natural objects where you find them, including rocks, feathers, and flowers.

Protect Resources! Stay off closed areas including Chapel Rock. Do not carve into trees, cliffs, or signs.

Pack out all trash and food. Do not put trash in toilets or bear boxes.

Human Waste: For everyone's health, if a toilet is not available, go 200 feet from any water source and bury human waste 6–8 inches in the soil and pack out toilet paper.



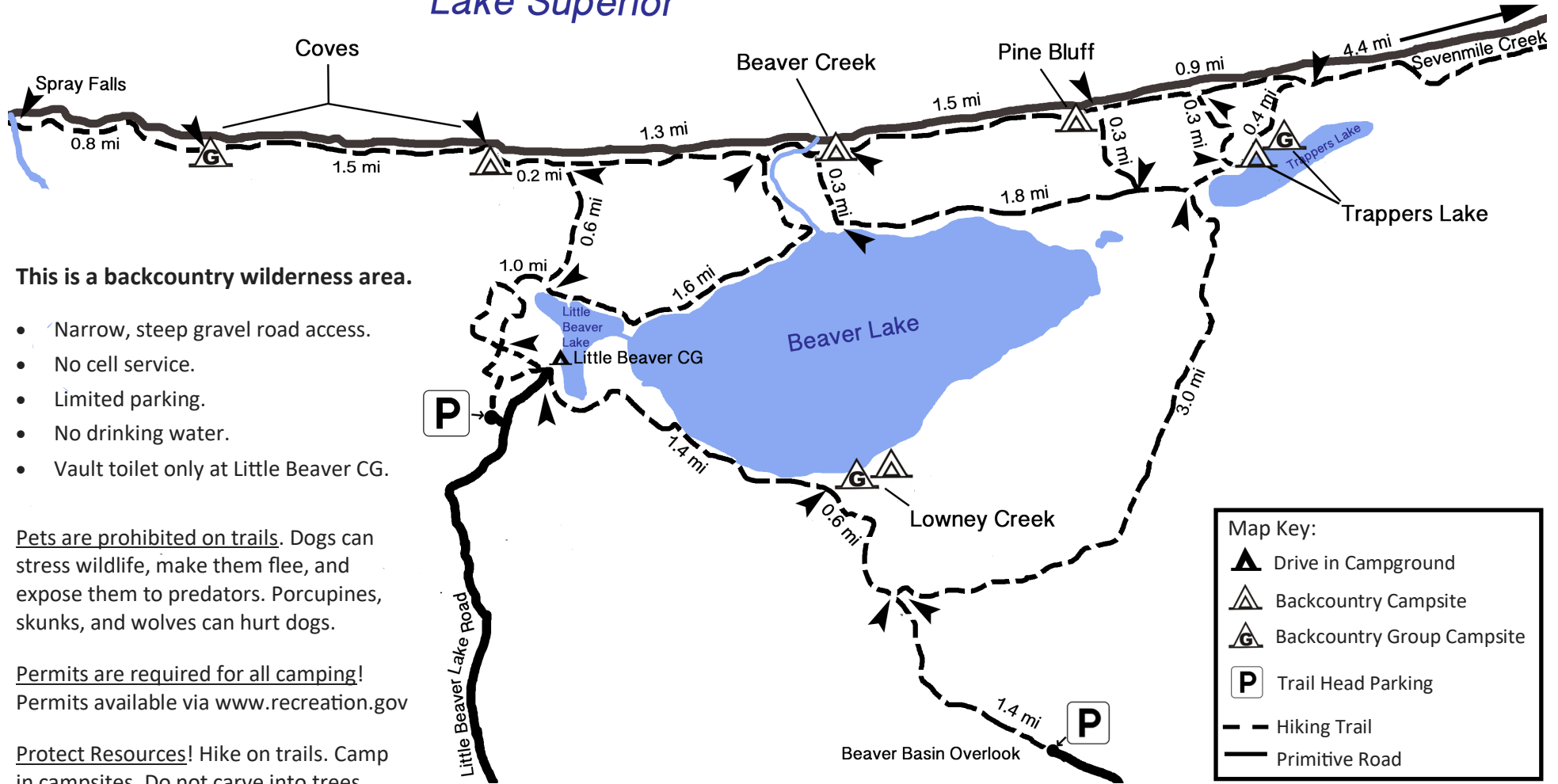

This is a backcountry wilderness area.

- Narrow, steep gravel road access.
- No cell service.
- Limited parking.
- No drinking water.
- Vault toilet only at Little Beaver CG.

Pets are prohibited on trails. Dogs can stress wildlife, make them flee, and expose them to predators. Porcupines, skunks, and wolves can hurt dogs.

Permits are required for all camping!
Permits available via www.recreation.gov

Protect Resources! Hike on trails. Camp in campsites. Do not carve into trees, cliffs, or signs.

Leave natural objects where you find them, including rocks, feathers, and flowers.

Pack out all trash and food. Do not put trash in toilets or bear boxes.

Human Waste: If a toilet is not available, go 200 feet from any water source and bury human waste 6–8 inches in the soil and pack out toilet paper.
