**Subject: Notification of Proposed Land Exchanges between the United States and Private Landowners (Giacomini and Pasternak), Golden Gate National Recreation Area Extension of Review Date to March 24, 2006**

Dear Interested Party:

We previously sent you information that the United States National Park Service is contemplating two land exchanges at Golden Gate National Recreation Area, Marin County, California, involving federal lands and lands owned by the Giacomini Trust (Giacomini), and Mark B. and Myriam Kaplan Pasternak (Pasternak), that are administered by Point Reyes National Seashore.

Notices of Realty Action (NORA) were published once a week for three weeks in the *Point Reyes Light* and *Marin Independent Journal*, commencing on January 12, 2006, for Giacomini and Pasternak, respectively. The National Park Service also notified all relevant federal, state and county officials, as well as adjacent landowners and interested parties, regarding these land exchanges. **Because of public comments, we have extended the public review period for the exchanges until Friday, March 24, 2006.**

The purpose of the Giacomini exchange is to acquire sensitive lands near Inverness Park that are critical for the Giacomini wetlands restoration project (9.61 acres). In return, the Giacomini Trust would receive lands adjacent to Point Reyes Station and an improved property near Inverness Park (5.38 acres).
