CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:	An evening wildfire has burned 800 acres August 18 in a remote area of the Point Reyes National Seashore, Smoke impacts throughout Marin and San Francisco counties.
Evacuations:	An evacuation warning was issued in coastal sections of West Marin, and an evacuation center was set up at West Marin School in Point Reyes Station. The warning was directed to residents living and visiting west of Shoreline Highway (State Route 1) between Sir Francis Drake Boulevard in Olema south to Bolinas, a stretch of about 11.5 miles. The warning area is sparsely populated.
