List of Killed and Wounded- 5th Georgia regiment.

The following is a list of the casualties in the 5th Ga. Regiment, in the fight 31st December 1862, before Murfreesboro:

Killed – Col Wm T Black.

Co. A, Clinch Rifles from Augusta, Ga.

Killed – Privs. [sic] Newton Rice and T W Morgan.

Wounded – Corpl [sic] J J Miller, Priv [sic] W J Milner, slightly. Privs [sic] A C B Holt, H M Walton, W P Stead, severely.

Co. B. Griffin, Light Guards, from Griffin, Ga.

Wounded – Lt. W J Duffie, Sergt [sic] G W Burr, Sergt [sic] J W Duffie, slightly; Priv [sic] A J Burr, seriously wounded with colors, having taken them when the color-bearer was shot down.

Co. C, Irish, Volunteers, from Augusta.

Killed – Corpl. [sic] Michael McNamara

Wounded – Privs [sic] Charles Cody, Timothy Sullivan, C Hanlin, severely; Thos [sic] Mohoney, slightly.

Co. D, McDuffie Rifles, from Warrenton, Ga.

Wounded – Capt [sic] Wm. B Hundley, Sergt [sic] G P Hudson, J B Harlow, slightly; Corpl [sic] W C Barksdale, very slightly; Sergt [sic] E E Cody, Priv [sic] J M English, J W Story, R M Shirley, severely.

Co. E, Dawson Volunteers, from Dawson, Ga.

Killed – Color-bearer, Thos [sic] J Brantly.

Wounded- Sergt [sic] J M Hush, saverely [sic], Corpl [sic] W S Beard, Priv [sic] J M Horn, slightly; Priv [sic] W J Johnston, mortally

Co. F, Cuthbert Rifles, Cuthbert, Ga.

Killed – Sergt [sic] S P Kiddoo.

Wounded – Capt J F Kiddoo, very slightly: Sergt [sic] W D Ward, Corpl [sic] J J Jones, Priv [sic] PJ Sealey, slightly; Privs [sic] T K Skelton, J F Sealey, W C Jenkins, severely.

Co. G, Schley Guards, from Ellaville, Ga.

Killed – 1st Lt J W Eason – having taken the Colors after two Color-bearers being shot down, and Corpl [sic] Killabrew.

Wounded – Segt [sic] A C Cleveland, mortally – since died; Sergt [sic] J J Snipes, slightly; Priv [sic] Chas Womack, severely

Co. H, Hardee Rifles, Bainbridge, Ga.

Wounded – Sergt [sic] D W Taylor, mortally – since died; Corpl [sic] B Bedell, Privs [sic] G L Waters, Jno [sic] Pruitt, severely; J W Ogletree, slightly.

Co. I, Georgia Grays, Columbus, Ga.

Killed – Washington Ward.

Wounded – Sergts [sic] M V Cook, Jas Basley, Corpl [sic] L P Aenchbacker, Privs [sic] Geo Shearer, J S Everett, slightly; Privs [sic] G W Banks, L Guerry, severely.

Co. K, Upson Guards, Upson county, Ga.

Capt. W G Horsley, slightly wounded.

Killed - Priv, [sic] Geo Horsley.

Wounded – Sergt [sic] G P Birdsong, Corpl [sic] H T Jennings, Corpl [sic] J W Durough, slightly.

Total Killed 10; Wounded, 50.
