Payment Letter

I certify that the within named Landon S. Farquhar a Sergt. [sic] of Capt. Thomas Maddens [sic] Co. A. of the 9th Regt Ind. Vols. born in Indianola Co State of Texas, aged 24 years five feet eight inches high, dark complexion, grey eyes dark hair and by profession a Salesman, was enlisted by Capt. John B. Milroy at LaPorte Ind, on the 5th day of Sept. 1861 to serve for during the war, and was killed in the battle of Stones [sic] River Tenn, [sic] on the 31st day of December 1862.

The said Sergt. [sic] Landon S. Farquhar was last paid by Paymaster Major Webb to include the 31st day of Augt, [sic] 1862, and has pay due him from that time to the present [crossed out] date of his death.

he is indebted to the United States \$4.80/100 on account of Extra clothing.
