Resignation letter

Camp of 38th Reg't Illinois Infantry

2d Brigade, 1st Division 20th Army Corps

Near Murfreesboro Tenn. April 1st 1863

Lt. Col Goddard A.A.G.

I hereby respectfully tender my resignation as 1st Lieut. of Company "H" 38th Regt [sic] Illinois Infantry Vols for the following reason

I have been disabled and unfitted for duty for a considerable time past by an affection [sic] of the lungs; I do not believe that I will ever be able to resume my duty

I enclose Surgeon's Certificate

I have no government property in my possession; I am not indebted to the Government. There are no charges against me that I have any knowledge of: I have not been absent without leave; I was last paid by Major Holt to include August 31st 1862
