Please provide the requested information below. For properties not yet listed or determined eligible, applicants must request early in the process that their respective SHPO/THPO complete the worksheet, and provide photos, maps, or other documentation required by the SHPO/THPO to complete the worksheet.

Important: The African American Civil Rights Network Act of 2017 (the Act; public law 115-104) identifies the following thresholds to determine if an element would be eligible for inclusion in the AACR Network: "All units and programs of the [National Park] Service that are determined by the Secretary [of the Interior] to relate to the African American civil rights movement during the period from 1939 through 1968. With the consent of the property owner, other Federal, State, local, and privately owned properties that relate to the African American civil rights movement have a verifiable connection to the African American civil rights movement; are included in, or determined by the Secretary to be eligible for inclusion in, the National Register of Historic Places. Other governmental and nongovernmental facilities and programs of an educational, research, or interpretive nature that are directly related to the civil rights movement."
