

LODGING SERVICE CLASSIFICATIONS

| Classification | Definition | Examples |

| Rustic | Rustic lodging provides utilitarian accommodations (huts, cabins, tents, etc.) with few, if any, enhancements. Facilities have very limited amenities and are different from camping in that a structure is provided. Rustic lodging may not be accessible by vehicle, and may not provide electricity and water. Bathrooms and cooking are typically shared or centrally located. | Lewis Mountain Cabins (SHEN) Charit Creek Lodge (BISO) |
| Basic | Basic lodging is affordable, with a modest level of comfort and hospitality. | Best Western Quality Inn Cedar Pass Lodge (BADL) |
| Midscale | Midscale lodging is affordable, with a modestly enhanced level of facilities, décor and amenities. Services such as business centers, meeting rooms, fitness centers and restaurants may also be provided. | Comfort Inn Hampton Inn Zion Lodge (ZION) |
| Upscale | Upscale lodging consists of establishments that provide high levels of enhancements, amenities and services. Food and beverage, retail, meeting rooms and facilities, concierge, and bell services are typically available. Upscale lodging has a sense of distinctive place with an exceptional level of comfort. | Sheraton Renaissance El Tovar (GRCA) |
