Miami-Dade, FL The first set of recommendations, Strategies for Advancing Stewardship: Aligning Tourism, Theresa Coble Conservation, and Partnerships in the National Park Service, were developed as a result of the St. Louis, MO charge to the Board during the August 15-16, 2023 meeting. At that time, the National Park Service (NPS) Director requested that the Board develop recommendations to help inform the Aja DeCoteau NPS's work as it revised its 1999 tourism policy. Over the next year, the Tourism Committee Portland, OR worked hard on developing actionable recommendations to support this task.
