



Audio Tour



General Information

The Kingsley Plantation audio tour “The Lion’s Story Teller” provides visitors with an immersive experience of the past. We are pleased to offer this program free of cost. Simply pick up a device at the visitor center by asking a ranger and presenting photo identification.

The tour is available in several forms to meet visitors’ needs, including an audio described tour and a captioned tour. Simply let staff know which version is preferred.

The tour takes visitors throughout the grounds of Kingsley Plantation and into the lives of the free and enslaved people of Fort George Island.

A site map will be visible on the screen and will have a flashing dot at the stop currently playing to help guide you along the tour route.

The map is also printed on the reverse side of this page.

Tips for Use

The tour is about one hour in length.

Following the audio instructions is very important. Please follow the directions to move to a specific location or in a direction, as soon as it is given.

If at any point the device turns off or becomes unresponsive just return to the visitor center or ask a ranger for assistance.

Each stop on the tour will be marked with a small audio tour sign. Please stay in the vicinity of the sign while the current stop is playing.

The tour was designed specifically with little need for you to interact with the device. Each stop is triggered via a GPS signal, some days GPS reception may be poor, and triggering may be sluggish.

Once an audio segment starts, it will play through to completion. When that segment ends the device will be triggered to your current location. If a section of the tour repeats you can fast forward through by scrubbing the dot at the bottom of the screen.
