HISTORY

Charles Marland Glazier was a concessions employee for the Yellowstone Park Company in Yellowstone National Park. He died in 1939 while working in the park.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of the diary, photographs, and personal items of Charles Marland Glazier of his time working for the Yellowstone Park Company (YPC) in Yellowstone National Park as well as correspondence and an inventory created by the YPC following his death. The diary is very brief but does provide dates and types of work and activities while employed in Yellowstone. The photographs show a construction crew and the construction of a building as well as wildlife and portraits of a young man who is likely Glazier. The correspondence describes the return of Glazier's personal items to his estate, along with an inventory of the items. Several artifacts were separated into the museum collection.
