David R. Toeppen was born on April 5, 1927, in Illinois. While a student at Miami of Ohio University, he spent the summer of 1948, working at Camp Roosevelt Lodge. While working in the park, he dedicated a fair amount of time to photographing Yellowstone's natural wonders and beauty. He also took many photographs of his coworkers at Camp Roosevelt Lodge. After his employment in the park ended, he went on to start a family and enjoy a long career in the metalworking machinery business. He passed away in 2011. He always fondly remembered the summer of 1948, and cherished the time he spent at Yellowstone and the memories he made.

<i>DESCRIPTION</i>	This collection consists of 185 photographic slides that were taken by David R. Toeppen. The slides document multiple areas and geologic features within the park, including Mammoth, Norris Geyser Basin, Fountain Paint Pots, the Lower, Middle, and Upper Geyser Basins, Yellowstone Lake, and Canyon. There are also a few slides that feature people that worked in the park at the time, including Mr. Toeppen and his coworkers at Camp Roosevelt Lodge.
<i>ORGANIZATION</i>	The slides are organized based on the original order created by Mr. Toeppen. Each slide was assigned a number. Mr. Toeppen retained three slides, #9, #110, and #164, and each of these are marked with *** in the container list to denote this. Additionally, there was a miscount during the original labeling, so there is no slide #182.
