HISTORY

Scotty Chapman worked as a backcountry ranger.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of a diary, titled Notes on Fishing and Hunting, by Scotty Chapman, documenting his time working with fish and wildlife in Yellowstone National Park. The notes served as a basis for several publications on fishing and wildlife authored by Chapman in the 1960s.
