***HISTORY***

Charles E. Campbell served in the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC), working with company #581 at the Nez Perce Camp (YNP-5), near Old Faithful Geyser Basin in Yellowstone National Park.

***DESCRIPTION***

The collection consists of a photograph album documenting Charles E Campbell's service in the Civilian Conservation (CCC) at Yellowstone National Park. The album contains black and white and a few colorized images of the Nez Perce Camp (YNP-5), including several interior views. There are also numerous photographs of CCC enrollees, likely fellow company #581 members. Although the images are not labelled, they are of very high visual quality and depict many less documented aspects of CCC life at the camps.
