HISTORY

H. T. Nelson was a professor of engineering at Montana State College (now Montana State University-Bozeman). In the summer, he worked for the engineering department at Yellowstone National Park. In 1925, he led a project to install a telephone line over Sylvan Pass.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of images of telephone line construction over Sylvan Pass in Yellowstone National Park, led by Professor H. T. Nelson around 1925. The images include survey work, and line construction, including some rock-climbing type tasks. There are also views of the work camp and landscape of the area. There is also a photocopy of a newspaper article describing Nelson's work on the project.
