HISTORY

Frank Collins was the bus dispatcher and transportation agent for the Yellowstone Park Company from the 1940s through 1972.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of personal papers and photographs of Frank Collins, who worked for the Yellowstone Park Company in Yellowstone National Park from the 1940s to 1972. The collection includes a scrapbook, photographic prints, and copy negatives. The scrapbook includes a few family photographs as well as commercial ephemera, including numerous Haynes postcards. (Note: this item is most likely not from the Collins Family; it was purchased by the donor on eBay.) The photographic prints and copy negatives, made from photographs that remained with the family, focus strongly on transportation including stagecoaches, the YPC White motor buses, drivers, and visitors. There are also images of Mammoth Hot Springs area, including Fort Yellowstone.
