HISTORY

George and Mayme (Wiegand) Dallas were Gardiner and Livingston, Montana, residents who also worked as concessioner employees in Yellowstone National Park, probably for the Wylie Camps Company. Mayme's sisters Carolyn and Gladys also worked as seasonal concessioner employees, probably at the Geyser and/or Canyon Camps about 1915. Daughter Bernice also worked in the park, probably in the 1920s.

DESCRIPTION

Photographs and album of Mayme and George Dallas and members of their family who worked as concessions employees in Yellowstone National Park. The images depict the family in Yellowstone and in Gardiner, Montana. Views include several of the Wylie Camps and the Wylie Hotel in Gardiner. There are also images of concessions employees, particularly at the Canyon and Geyser Camps. Images are well labeled, and many include the names of those depicted. The photograph album also includes handwritten, Yellowstone-themed camp songs. The collection is notable for its earlier date and for the documentation of the Wylie Camps Co. employees, who are less well documented than other concessioners.
