***HISTORY***

The Augspurger family visited Yellowstone National Park in the 1940s. Marie Augspurger was a writer.

***DESCRIPTION***

The collections consist of scrapbooks, writings, film, photographic slides, and ephemera from Marie Augspurger. Marie Augspurger visited Yellowstone in the 1940s and subsequently wrote a small, informational publication about the park.

Bequest of Marie Augspurger, 1980. Additional materials donated in 1984. Glen Augspurger materials donated in 1976 and 1998. Collection was originally scattered to library and museum collections; it was reunited as an archival collection in 2018.
