HISTORY

Catherine Horan, later Brady, worked as a concession employee, probably for the Yellowstone Park Camps Company in 1929. Catherine worked as a waitress, or "heaver", in the park's lingo. From Lake Forest, Illinois, she was a college student at the time that she worked in Yellowstone National Park.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of photographs and memorabilia of Catherine "Kay" Horan (later Brady) working as a concessioner employee, known as a "savage", at Lake Lodge in 1929. The black and white images show the employees at work and play as well as features of Yellowstone National Park. The memorabilia includes a map, a Haynes Guide, a songbook, a luggage tag, and a what may be dining place card in the shape of a canoe.
