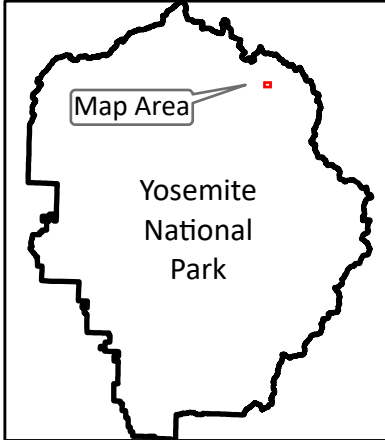


# Stock Site Evaluation Project Matterhorn Canyon North

Forage Area: Upper Matterhorn Canyon (3835) is an unverified forage area to the east. There is very limited understory forage at and surrounding the site, and a large meadow area 150 m south of the site.

Annual Grazing Capacity: 20 stock use nights

## Matterhorn Canyon - North

Camp ID: 77

Fire Ring: 288,201mE x 4,214,745mN

Handling Practices: This site is in the northern part of Matterhorn Canyon on the west side of Matterhorn Creek. The fire ring is approximately 10 m west of the NPS system trail. The unloading area and holding area are at the fire ring. Do not camp or hold stock east of the creek here due to concerns about stock use causing potential impacts to sensitive resources.
